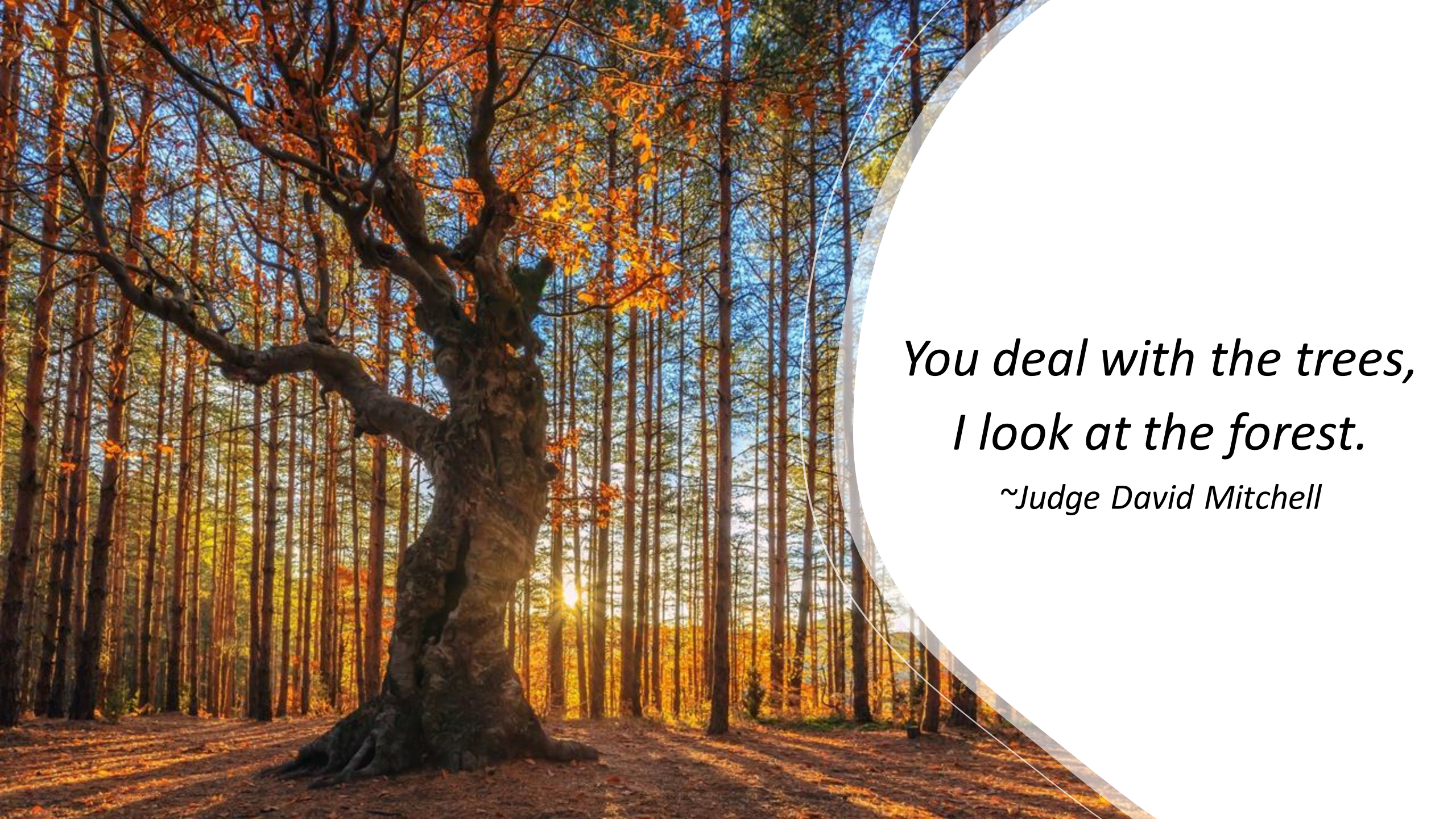

## **Continue**

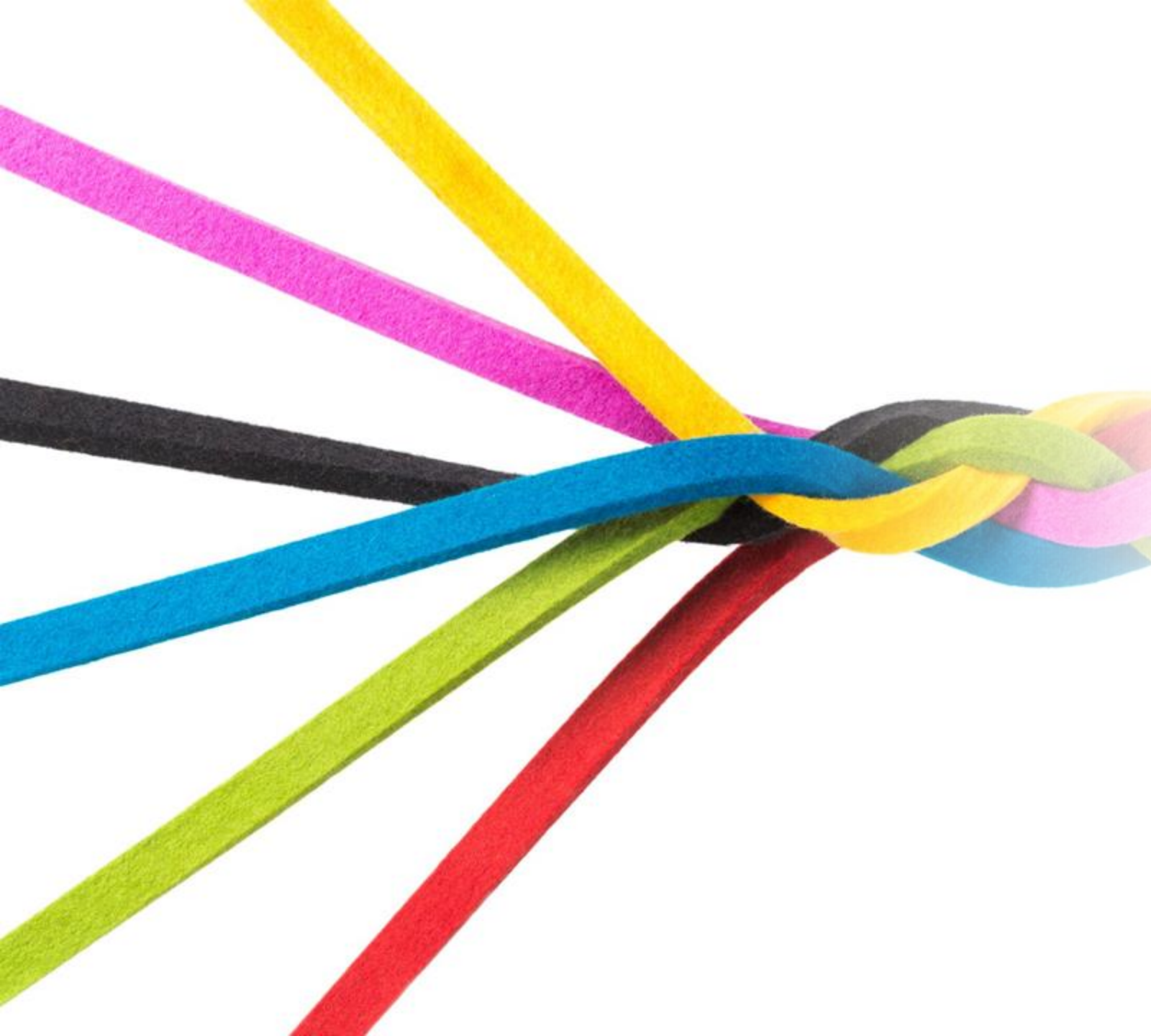
What's still working that you want to continue to do?
